What Are They Saying?

Slaven Bilić, Watford Head Coach:

"We know playing Blackpool is going to be a big challenge. We always talk about how the Championship is so tight, and there are no games where you can relax. Every team in this division has their own goals.

"They're a competitive side. We were dominant on the ball, but we lost the last game against them because we couldn't cope with their counter-attacking and our defending wasn't good enough, but we know what to do to change that."

Michael Appleton, Blackpool Head Coach:

"They've got good players in their team. I know they've got a few injuries, but you've only got to look at the top end of the pitch to see how strong they are as a unit."
